Clinical Pharmacology:

### Luliconazole:

Luliconazole is an antifungal medication that treats skin infections. It works by killing the fungi on the skin by destroying their cell membrane. It appears to inhibit ergosterol synthesis by inhibiting the enzyme lanosterol demethylase, resulting in decreased amounts of ergosterol and a corresponding accumulation of lanosterol. This treats your skin infection.

#### **Indications:**

Treatment of Fungal skin infections

- Athlete's foot
- Dhobie Itch
- Thrush
- Ringworm
- Dry, flaky skin.

**Contraindications:** No contraindications as used topically.

## **Precautions and Warnings:**

- Appropriate use: For topical use only; not for oral, ophthalmic, or intravaginal use.
- Unsafe to use during pregnancy and breast feeding.

## **Drug Interactions:**

Use of Amisulpride and Luliconazole should be avoided at the same time. Luliconazole is expected to increase Amisulpride levels, which may result in potential lifethreatening abnormal heart rate.

#### **Adverse Effects:**

- Application site irritation
- Itching
- Skin exfoliation.

Overdosage: This medicine may be harmful if swallowed. .

**Route of Administration:** Topical Check the label for directions before use. Clean and dry the affected area and apply the cream. Wash your hands after applying, unless hands are the affected area.

**Dosage:** Apply to affected area and ~1 inch of immediate surrounding area(s) as directed by physician

**Storage:** Store below 25°C (68°F to 77°F); do not freeze. Protect from light and sunlight.
